

1 Decision on Submitted Matter and ordered counsel for Petitioner to
2 prepare, serve and lodge a proposed Statement of Decision, Judgment and
3 Writ, on or before December 14, 2000. Respondents were given to
4 December 28, 2000, to serve and file objections. Respondents filed
5 lengthy objections on January 19, 2001, and Petitioners lodged a revised
6 proposed Statement of Decision, Judgment and Writ, as well as a Response
7 to Respondent's objections on February 13, 2001. After consideration of
8 all of the above, the Court having now signed and filed a Statement of
9 Decision,

10 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, DECLARED AND ORDERED that:

11 1. A Peremptory Writ of Mandamus shall issue under seal of this
12 Court, directing Respondents:

13 a. To vacate California Regional Water Quality Control Board,
14 Los Angeles Region Order Nos. 98-072 (Time Schedule Order), the
15 Contested Effluent Limits contained in Order #98-052, NPDES No. 0055531,
16 and provisions specifying manner of compliance and to adopt revised
17 orders, in accordance with the Court's Statement of Decision and
18 applicable federal and state law.


19 b. To file with the Court a return demonstrating the
20 Respondent's compliance with paragraph 1(a) of this Judgment. The
21 return shall be served and filed within 90 days from the date of service
22 by Petitioner of the Notice of Entry of Judgment. The Stay of the
23 Contested Effluent Limitations granted by this Court in December, 1999,
24 shall remain in effect until the return is served and filed by
25 Respondents with this Court.

26 2. Petitioner, as the prevailing party in this action, shall
27 recover costs in this proceeding in the amount of \$ _____.

1 3. The Court shall reserve jurisdiction to consider any motion for
2 attorneys' fees by Petitioner. Any motion for attorney's fees in this
3 matter shall be deemed timely if filed and served within 60 days after
4 the date of mailing by the clerk of the notice of entry of judgment in
5 this action.
